Signature Block Fundraising Pattern/Directions

One of our major fund raising ideas is to make square in a square blocks with white center squares for attendees at the NJ State Fair to sign which are made into quilts. The colored fabric is 6" square cut on the diagonal from donated fabric scraps from our guild members and the center is a 5" square. Points don't have to match so it is a forgiving way for multiple people to work on quilts. Fifty six blocks are in the quilt with borders to enlarge it to the required size. The blocks are oriented every which way to permit anyone at the bedside to read one no matter where they are standing. One or two blank squares for family members, friends, caretakers or hospital staff to sign are included in the quilt. We have found that it is our most popular quilt with recipients as they read each message with care.
